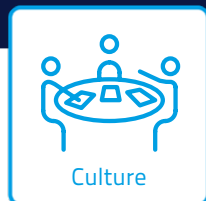


# Committed to your safety

## 300 million passengers will travel this year on airways managed by ENAIRe

Safety is the cornerstone of mobility and one of the pillars of the United Nations 2030 Agenda. This is expressly stated in the "Report on the Safety of Transport and Infrastructure" of the Ministry of Public Works, published in February 2019. Without safety there is no air, rail, port or road transport.

Above all other considerations, safety is the common priority to all the links that make up the air transport value chain.

We have a regulatory framework that translates into strategic lines and specific actions in the National Operational Safety Programme (PESO) and ENAIRe's Action Plan to Enhance Operational Safety (PARSO), which are implemented through the Safety Management System (SGS).

Spain has a very safe transport system, but we must persevere as part of the process of constant improvement in order to continue reinforcing all three of its facets: safety, security and cybersecurity.

300 million passengers travel on airways managed by ENAIRe every year, 300 million lives in our hands, 300 million reasons to renew our commitment to air transport safety every day.

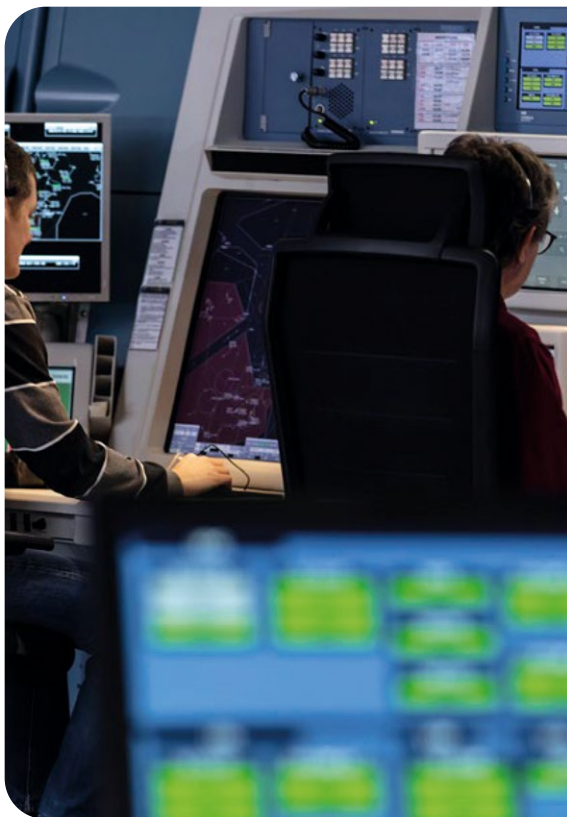
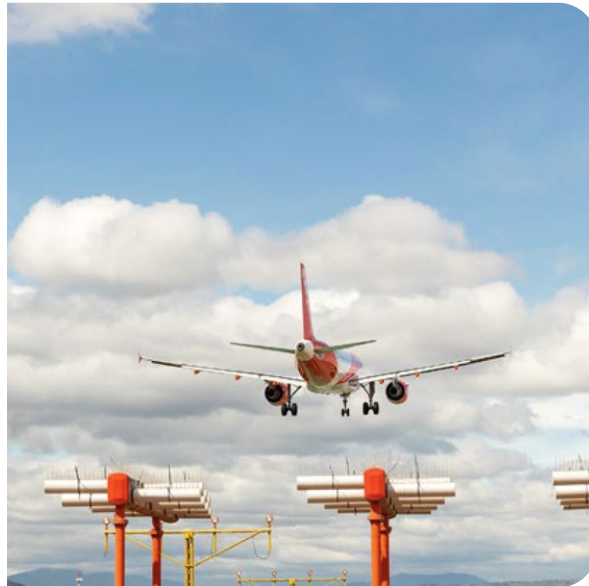
### A firm conviction

And the most effective communication is one that places the emphasis on information, disclosure, awareness and participation.



Our goal with these Safety Clips is to report on safety effectively. This format allows for easy publication, meaning the content will be more recent and relevant.

They are short, to the point and contain features that will let you absorb the key information at a glance. They are designed so you can understand the content before opening them, just by previewing them on your PC. We know that your time is important.

Their format is that of a printable collectable. These sheets will be related to one another; the main way to do this is with thematic tags. In addition to being used to classify the Clips, the tags will let you know if the Clip addresses an area of interest to you and they will form "families" with mutually enriching information.

The Safety Clips will be classified into: operations, meteorology, management, drones, civil-military, regulations, organisations, human factors, technology and training.
